Welcome to the 30th Year of the Silver State Classic Challenge!

The event dates of the 2017 season are:

CHIHUAHUA EXPRESS, International Series – April 27-30, 2017

NEVADA OPEN ROAD CHALLENGE (NORC) – MAY 18-21, 2017

SILVER STATE CLASSIC CHALLENGE (SSCC) – SEPTEMBER 14-17, 2017

The NORC & SSCC are exciting Nevada open road events, on the recently renamed “**Silver State Classic Challenge Highway**”, also known as Hwy. 318, that offers a speed class for everyone! The classes range from 95 mph and increase in 5 mph increments to the 150, plus the 160, 170, 180 and Unlimited. First, Second and Third place trophies are awarded to the Driver and Navigator in each class. First Second and Third place trophies are also awarded to the Drivers of the One-Mile and Half-Mile Shootouts. Those that participate in the Chihuahua Express and at least one SSCC event will be automatically entered in the International Series and the winner will be awarded a Trophy in September.

The **2017 RULE BOOK** will be available on our web site by the end of February. There may be **changes to the rules**. It is **your responsibility to know the rules!** Please be sure you have read the current Rules and any changes that will impact you. The **Nevada Department of Transportation** requires each participant have current **medical insurance**. You will be **required to sign** a statement when you register attesting that “I have current Medical Insurance.”

To participate in any SSCC event, all drivers and navigators must have a current membership. To register for the event, simply go to our website and enter on-line or contact us at (775) 289-6900 or email sscc.us@gmail.com to receive an entry packet by mail.

The SSCC is a non-profit corporation that consists of all volunteers, including the Board of Directors, that help to put on the events. **Driver's Entry fee includes** two (2) t-shirts, admittance for you and your family/crew to the Press Luncheon, Thursday Cocktail Party and also the Friday Welcome Reception. The fees also include admittance for two (2) to the Awards Banquet in Las Vegas. Extra tickets for the Award's Banquet may be purchased.

The location for Registration in Ely on Friday and Saturday is at the Bristlecone Convention Center, in the Pinion & Sage Rooms. The location of registration on Thursday at Sam's Town Hotel remains the same.

First Time Participants must attend Qualifying School held on Thursday of race weekend at Las Vegas Motor Speedway. **The school starts PROMPTLY at 6:00am and you must wear the same Safety Equipment as required for the Division in which you are competing.**

The Half Mile and One Mile Shootouts will both take place on Friday. If by chance they are rained out on Friday, they will both take place on Saturday. Please refer to the Schedule of Events for times.

The only way to watch these events is to **become a course worker as there are No Spectator Areas!** We need course workers to secure the gates along Hwy. 318. For more information go to our website or contact us for more information.
