

Welcome to the 31st Year of the Silver State Classic Challenge!

NEVADA OPEN ROAD CHALLENGE (NORC) – MAY 17-20, 2018 (119.78 Miles, Two-Way Event)
SILVER STATE CLASSIC CHALLENGE (SSCC) – SEPTEMBER 13-16, 2018 (90 Miles, One-Way Event)

SSCC is a non-profit corporation with a dedicated volunteer Board of Directors and staff who annually host the NORC and SSCC Open Road Racing events on Nevada State Highway 318, aka the *Silver State Classic Challenge Highway*.

This year, SSCC is offering two completely different event formats. The NORC in May will be a two-way event, totaling 119.78 miles (59.89 each way), with the NORC Awards Banquet to be held in Ely, Nevada. The SSCC in September remains our classic 90-mile, one-way event, with the SSCC Awards Banquet to be held in Las Vegas, Nevada.

SSCC hosts time, speed, distance events. Classes begin at 95 mph, and increase in 5 mph increments up through the 160 mph class, plus a 170, 180, and Unlimited class (only in the SSCC). First, Second and Third place trophies are awarded to the Driver and Navigator/Co-driver in each class. Trophies are also awarded to drivers of our companion One-Mile and Half-Mile Shootout events. Those who participate in the Chihuahua Express, and at least one SSCC event, will be automatically entered in our International Series, the winner of which will also be awarded a trophy in September.

The 2018 SSCC Rule Book is available on our <u>SSCC.US</u> web site. *There are new changes to the rules this season.* Be sure you have read the current rules, and take note of any changes that will impact you. Remember, *it is your responsibility to know the rules.* Be aware, the Nevada Department of Transportation now requires each participant have current medical insurance. You are required to submit a copy of your medical insurance card with your entry.

All drivers and navigators/co-drivers must have a current SSCC membership to participate in events,. To join SSCC, or register for events, visit SSCC.US, call (775) 289-6900, or email sscc.us@gmail.com to request an entry packet by mail.

NORC and SSCC Driver entry fees include: Event entry for one (1) vehicle, one (1) event t-shirt, admittance for you and your family/crew to the Thursday and Friday evening events, and admittance for one (1) to the Awards Banquet.

NORC and SSCC Navigator/Co-driver entry fees include: Event entry for one (1) vehicle, one (1) event t-shirt, admittance for you and your family/crew to the Thursday and Friday evening events, and admittance for one (1) to the Awards Banquet. Additional tickets for the Awards Banquet are available, but must be pre-purchased for catering purposes.

Registration sign in and on-site packet pickup for the NORC will be held at the Bristlecone Convention Center in Ely on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Registration sign in and on-site packet pickup for the SSCC will be held in Las Vegas at Sam's Town Hotel and Casino on Thursday, and at the Bristlecone Convention Center in Ely on Friday and Saturday.

All first time SSCC event participants will be considered rookies, and unless other instructional documentation or racing experience has been submitted and approved in advance by the SSCC race director, must attend the SSCC rookie driver school. Rookie school will be held the Thursday of NORC and SSCC event weekends at SPEEDVEGAS, located on South Las Vegas Boulevard, and will begin promptly at 7:00 AM Pacific time. Individual SSCC rookie school sessions are also available in advance of event weekends, and must be booked directly through SPEEDVEGAS. Certificates of qualification are good for up to eighteen (18) months from date of issue.

SSCC Half-Mile and One-Mile Shootout events will take place in Ely on Friday. In case of inclement weather, the Shootout events will take place on Saturday. Please refer to NORC/SSCC Schedule of Events for times and locations.

Due to the high-speeds and remote locations of our events, unfortunately there are no spectator viewing areas. However, your family, friends, and crew can view SSCC events by becoming course workers. We're always looking for additional course workers to help secure the gates along the course on Highway 318. Contact us for information on how to sign up.
