Thank you for your interest in our events and being a course worker on the recently renamed "**Silver State Classic Challenge Highway**", also known as Highway 318.

Silver State Classic Challenge is the oldest open road event in America. It takes place every May and September on Nevada's Hwy 318. On Sunday of race weekend, racers go Flat Out on the public highway between Lund and Hiko. **There are no spectator areas.** However, being a course worker and securing gates along Hwy 318 allows you to be able to watch the entire event. This is the **only way** to watch these exciting events!

The primary responsibility of being a course worker is controlling access through the gate where you are assigned and staying there until the event is declared officially over by the Event Director. **No one** can use the highway until the event is officially finished. This notification is transmitted to course workers by a hand-held radio that is supplied by SSCC.

Sign in starts at 8:30 AM, so the briefing can start on time.** Plan to spend about 1 ½-2 hours at orientation for instructions on responsibilities, verifying gate assignments and signing necessary waiver forms.
